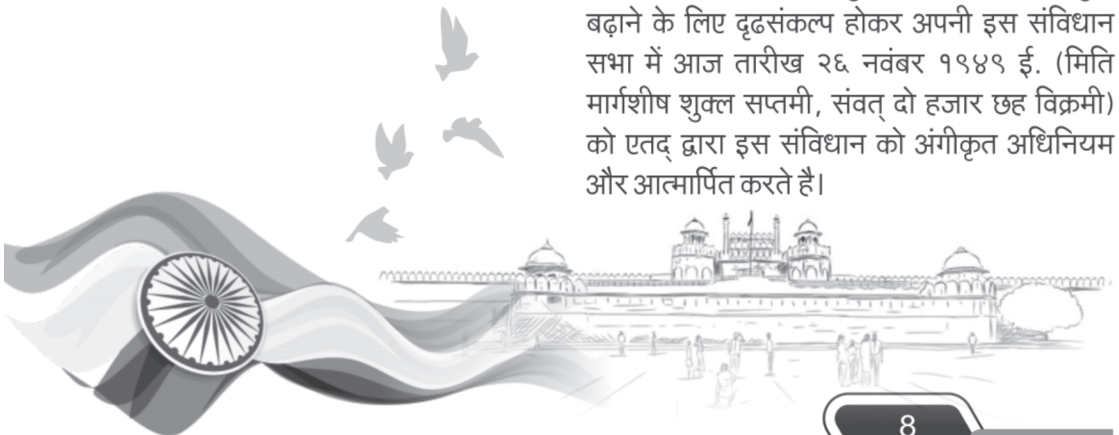

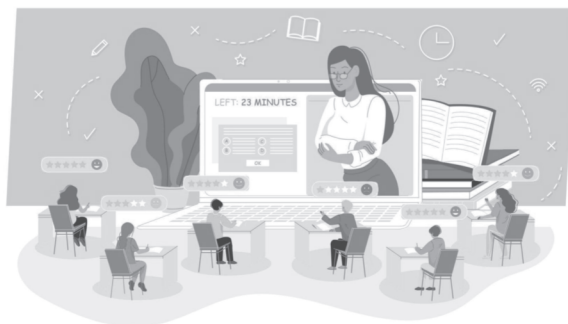
Examination

Std. III to V : There will be two types of Assessments as under.

1. **Periodic Assessment :** There will be four formative assessment in a year. Two in first term and two in second term. In each formative assessment the teachers will use various tools and techniques to assess the child.
2. **Summative Assessment :** There will be two summative assessment at the end of each term and evaluation will be written examination, here the students will be evaluated on the entire course taught in the term. The students are expected to remain present for all assessments. It is compulsory for the students to appear in both summative Assessment - I and Summative Assessment - II.

Progress Report will be shown to the parents after each summative assessment, parents are requested to meet the principal to discuss remedial measures if the students has not reached qualifying grade.

Only parents are permitted to sign on Report Card.



Library

1. All students are members of the school library.
2. Students must read silently in the library and maintain complete silence.
3. Only one book will be issued at a time for a duration of one week from Std. VII onwards. One who fails to return a book, will have to pay a fine.
4. The students are not to take any book from the library without proper entry in the issue register by the librarian.
5. Fine will be charged for damages done to the books.
6. If the borrower card is lost Rs. 10/- will be paid for duplicate card.
7. Books lost must be replaced by the borrower within a fortnight or the cost of the book must be paid as fine.
8. Reference books, magazines, news papers, chairs should be properly placed in respective racks before leaving the library.
9. Keep the library clean, please remember that the LIBRARY is yours and is for your benefit.

Admission

- ◆ Admission of new students is done before the beginning of the academic session.
- ◆ The student should fulfill the following minimum age requirement for getting admission as on.


Pre-Nursery	:	2.5 Years and above.
Nursery	:	3 Years complete till 30 Sept.
KG-I	:	4 Years complete till 30 Sept.
KG-II	:	5 Years complete till 30 Sept.
Std. - I	:	6 Years complete till 30 Sept.
- ◆ Parents or guardians are given to understand that they can not dictate terms to the management and that the management has the right to say on what conditions it will admit or retain pupils in the school.
- ◆ Re admission is compulsory for your ward when he / she is promoted from KG-II to Std. I.

Withdrawals

1. Before withdrawing a student from the school the guardian must send an application and formally fill in the prescribed form at least 3 days in advance.
2. Leaving certificate will be issued only after all the dues to the school have been paid to the full.
3. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, neglect of homework, disobedience, disrespect to members of the school, staff, bad moral influence and communicable diseases harmful to other students will result in the removal of the students from the school.
4. The Principal may at her absolute discretion require any parent at any time take his / her ward out of school.

The School Assembly

The morning session begins with the assembly. All students and staff members are expected to join this. After the prayer, pledge taking and short speeches by the students or members of the staff, thought for the day, Daily News, Special Program, National Anthem the regular classes of the day will start. While participating in the assembly, students must observe proper decorum and solemnity befitting the occasion.

School Transport Rules

- ◆ Parents are requested to ensure that the student is escorted to and from the bus stop.
- ◆ Student must travel by the route that is allotted to them. No changes will be allowed in between the session.

The transport facility provided by Swami Awadheshanand Public School & Junior College will cover the majority of areas but it will not be obligatory on the part of the School Authorities to make new routes or to extend routes or to create additional stops.

- ◆ Parents are requested to ensure that the student is escorted to and from the bus stop.
- ◆ Student must travel by the route that is allotted to them. No changes will be allowed in between the session.
- ◆ Eating in the buses or littering is not permitted.
- ◆ Strict discipline to be maintained in the buses while travelling to school. Behaviour on the bus should be cautious. More than one complaint of indiscipline in the bus will result in withholding / withdrawing the transport facility of the child.

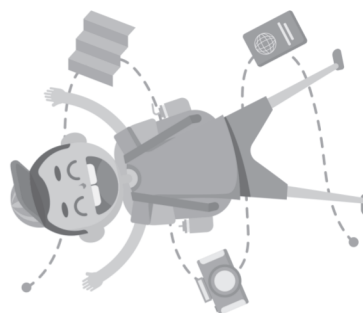
